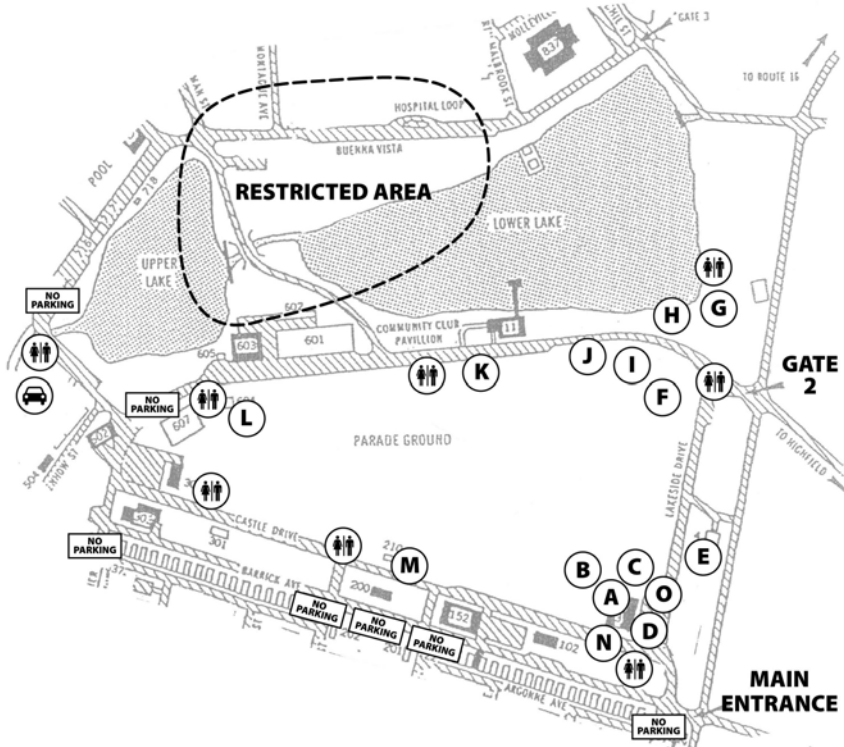


MAP OF FORT RITCHIE
